

Wash'Em Workshop

LENGTH: 24 hours (6 days)

Time per session: 4 hours per day

DESCRIPTION

Wash'Em is a process for rapidly designing evidence-based and context-adapted handwashing behaviour change programmes in emergencies. The Wash'Em process simplifies handwashing behavior change program design into three steps; Step 1- Learning about your target community. Step 2- Entering your data into the Program Designer Software and Step 3- Generate recommendations. This workshop is adapted based on the process developed by Centre for Affordable Water and Sanitation Technology (CAWST), London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine, Action Contre La FAIM (ACF) and United States Agency for International Development (USAID).

Wash'Em workshop uses a participatory approach that provides participants with hands-on practice using the Wash'Em rapid assessment tools (handwashing demonstration, personal histories, motives, disease perception and touch points) to collect and analyze the data. Additionally, it includes the importance of hand washing promotion including behavioural theory and informed consent, tips for interviewing and focus group discussion, planning to mitigate distress during interview.

The whole Wash'Em process can be done in less than a week. The Wash'Em tools can be learn in a day, the data can be collected in 2 days and programme can be designed in a day. The Wash'Em puts crisis-affected populations at the heart of programming. Wash'Em can help the organisation meet the Core Humanitarian Standards.

OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of the workshop, participants will be able to design the context-adapted handwashing behaviour change programmes in emergencies
